

ORDINANCE NO. 574

AN ORDINANCE BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, MISSISSIPPI, AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 354 OF THE CITY, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NUMBERS 256, 2918, 311, 319, 339 361 414 AND 418 TO EXTEND THE PERMITTED HOURS FOR ON-PREMISES SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

Having made due investigation and consideration, and in order to promote the general health, welfare, safety and convenience of the citizens of the city of Long Beach,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, MISSISSIPPI, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** Sub- section (b) of Section 2 of Ordinance No. 254 of the City, entitled, "AN ORDINANCE BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, MISSISSIPPI, REGULATING THE SALE OF BEER, WINE OR OTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN SAID CITY, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF ANY PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH" as amended by Ordinance Numbers 256, 289, 311, 319, 339, 361, 414 and 418, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

(b) On-premises permittees or clubs located within those areas in the city classified as resort areas under the provisions of the Local Option Alcoholic Beverage Control Law of the State of Mississippi, may make sales of alcoholic beverages at the permitted locations between the hours of 10:00 o'clock a.m. each day and 3:00 o'clock a.m. the following day. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, give away, furnish or deliver any alcoholic beverage for consumption on the premises except as herein permitted.

**SECTION 2.** Effective Date - This ordinance shall take effect and be and force thirty (30) days after its adoption, publication and enrollment thereof as provided by

law.

The above and foregoing Ordinance No. 574 was introduced in writing by Alderman Ponthieux who moved its adoption. Alderman Couvillon seconded the motion to adopt the Ordinance, and after discussion, no member of the Board of Aldermen having requested the Ordinance to be read by the City Clerk, and the question being put to a roll call vote, the result was as follows:
