For example, the individuals with service animals are welcomed in the City of Long Beach offices, even where pets are generally prohibited.

Anyone who requires an auxiliary aid or service for effective communication, or a modification of policies or procedures to participate in a program, service, or activity of the City of Long Beach, should contact the office of John Eustace, ADA Coordinator, (228) 863-1554, as soon as possible but no later than 48 hours before the scheduled event.

The ADA does not require the City of Long Beach to take any action that would fundamentally alter the nature of its programs or services, or impose an undue financial or administrative burden.

Complaints that a program, service, or activity of the City of Long Beach is not accessible to persons with disabilities should be directed to John Eustace, ADA Coordinator, and (228) 863-1554.

The City of Long Beach will not place a surcharge on a particular individual with a disability or any group of individuals with disabilities to cover the cost of providing auxiliary aids/services or reasonable modifications of policy, such as retrieving items from locations that are open to the public but are not accessible to persons who use wheelchairs.

City of Long Beach Grievance Procedure under The Americans with Disabilities Act

This Grievance Procedure is established to meet the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 ("ADA). It may be used by anyone who wishes to file a complaint alleging discrimination on the basis of disability in the provisions of services, activities, programs, or benefits by the City of Long Beach. The City of Long Beach's Personnel Policy governs employment-related complaints of disability discrimination.

The complaint should be in writing and contain information about the alleged discrimination such as name, address, phone number of complainant and location, date and description of the problem. Alternative means of filing complaints, such as personal interviews or a tape recording of the complaint, will be made available for persons with disabilities upon request.

The complaint should be submitted by the grievant and/or his/her designee as soon as possible but no later than 60 calendar days after the alleged violation to:

Within 15 calendar days after the receipt of the complaint, John Eustace, or his designee, Griff Skellie, will meet with the complainant to discuss the complaint and the possible resolutions. With 15 calendar of the meeting, John Eustace or his designee, Griff Skellie,

will respond in writing, and where appropriate, in a format accessible to the complainant, such as large print, Braille, or audio tape. The response will explain the position of the City of Long Beach and offer options for substantive resolution of the complaint.

If the response by John Eustace of his designee, Griff Skellie, does not satisfactorily resolve the issue, the complainant and/or his/her designee may appeal the decision within 15 calendar days after receipt of the response to the City Clerk or her designee.

Within 15 calendar days after the receipt of the appeal, the City Clerk, Rebecca E. Schruff, or her designee, Stacey Dahl, will meet with the complainant to discuss the complaint and possible resolutions. Within 15 calendar days after the meeting, the City Clerk Rebecca E. Schruff, or her designee, Stacey Dahl, will respond in writing, and where appropriate, in a format accessible to the complainant, with a final resolution of the complaint.

All written complaints received by John Eustace or his designee, Griff Skellie, appeals to the City Clerk Rebecca E. Schruff or her designee, Stacey Dahl, and responses from these two offices will be retained by the City of Long Beach for at least three years.
