Ladies and Gentlemen:

The referenced subdivision was platted in early 2008, based on a punchlist baced by a \$301,000 completion bond meeting the requirements of the subdivision ordinance. An extensive delay in completing the work resulted due to disagreements over construction and payment. In the past, no Certificates of Occupancy were issued for this phase of the subdivision because the sewer system was not ready for use.

However, recently, the development has finally been completed in accordance with the 2008 punchlist requirements and to my satisfaction and that of the Public Works department. The developer has also promised to relocate any water and sewer services which are incorrectly located per the attached letter from Mr. Robert Knesal, the design engineer.

Based upon the above, we recommend that the City make final acceptance of the completion of the subdivision, allowing the issuance of building permits and construction of residential homes to proceed. When the subdivision was originally platted in 2008, a warranty bond would have been posted with the City, but that bond may have expired or been otherwise invalidated prior to this time. Consequently, we also recommend that the warranty bond in the amount of \$97,285 be renewed or otherwise validated to the satisfaction of the City Clerk.




